Please bring bedding, towels, pillows and warm clothes for evenings, flashlight, musical instruments if you like, games, whatever you need to feel comfortable. A refrigerator is available for special food needs or medications. Meals served will accommodate most dietary requirements, including vegetarian and vegan diets. Coffee and tea provided. We will have cold drinks available for sale.

*Coming north on 101, exit State Street/Lake Cachuma/Highway 154. Cross State Street and at next intersection, transition onto 154 (right hand turn).

*Coming south on 101, exit State Street exit, stay in left lane and take first left, which will be Highway 154.

Rancho Alegre is 16.3 miles up Highway 154. (It will seem much farther because of all the twists and turns.) Directly across from the entrance is an emergency highway phone on the right side of the road. Entrance is on the left side of the road. You will see a large sign indicating Rancho Alegre. If you are coming in the opposite direction on 154, the entrance is 1 mile past the Lake Cachuma entrance. Try to get there before dark, as highway 154 is a two-lane mountain pass with no streetlights. The entrance is not lit. We will mark the entrance with balloons. Follow the turn-off road all the way to the end, where you will find the lodge.
